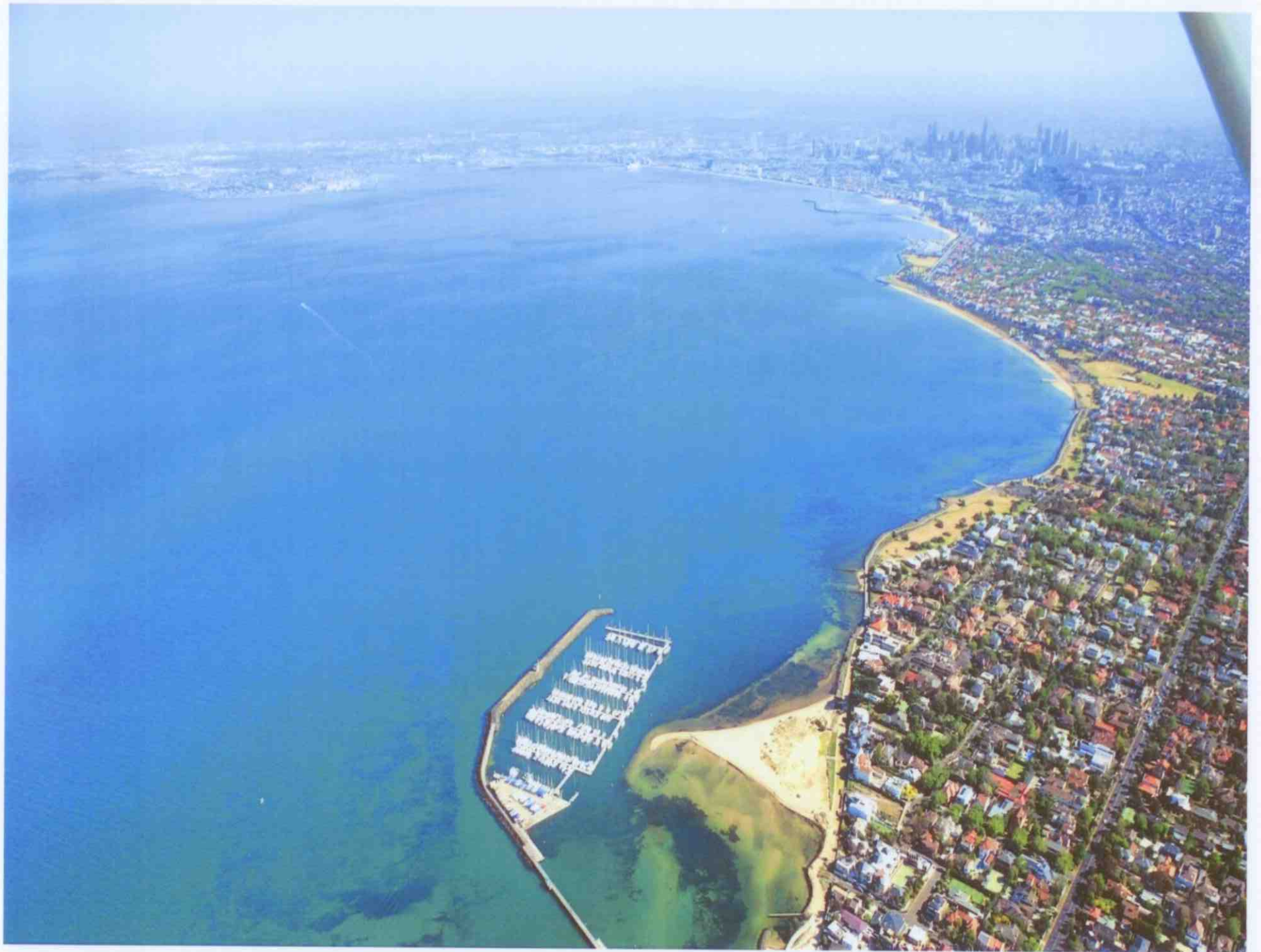


# Port Phillip

# Yacht Transport to RBYC

Bringing your Dragon to Melbourne in 3 easy steps:-

1. Deliver your dragon on a road trailer to a DB Schenker Depot in Hamburg, Amsterdam, Tilbury or Le Havre.
2. DB Schenker will deliver your container to the Melbourne Depot.
3. The Royal Brighton Yacht Club Championship team will take you to the depot to unpack and tow your boat and trailer to the Race Venue.

# DB Schenker Package

Package includes:-

- Local export customs formalities at origin cities
- Ocean freight to Melbourne
- Australian customs and quarantine formalities
- Importation under temporary and /or final entry
- Local logistics and coordination
- Delivery of your container to depot for unpacking
- The reverse of the above for the return to your origin

- 2) **Additional service- origin customs and export preparation**  
€ 1,500.00
- 3) **Australian Temporary customs clearance ( goods NOT on an ATA Carnet)**
