MARINA "HERCULES"

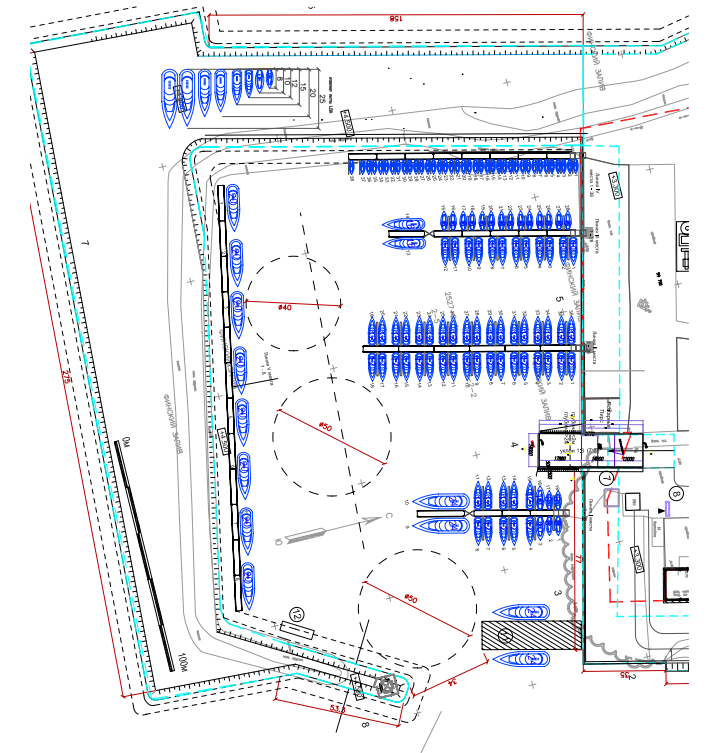


Hercules Yachting Port offers you:

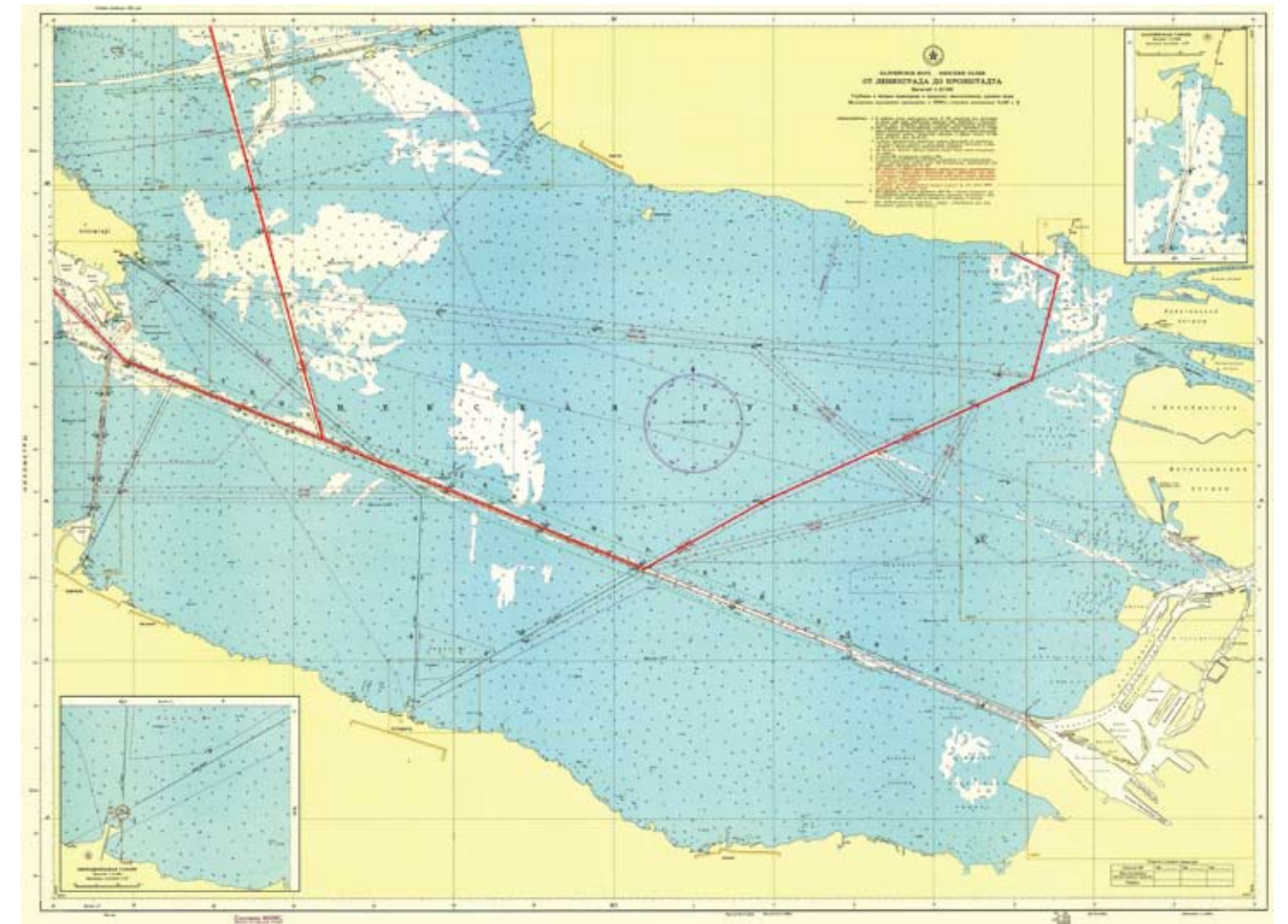
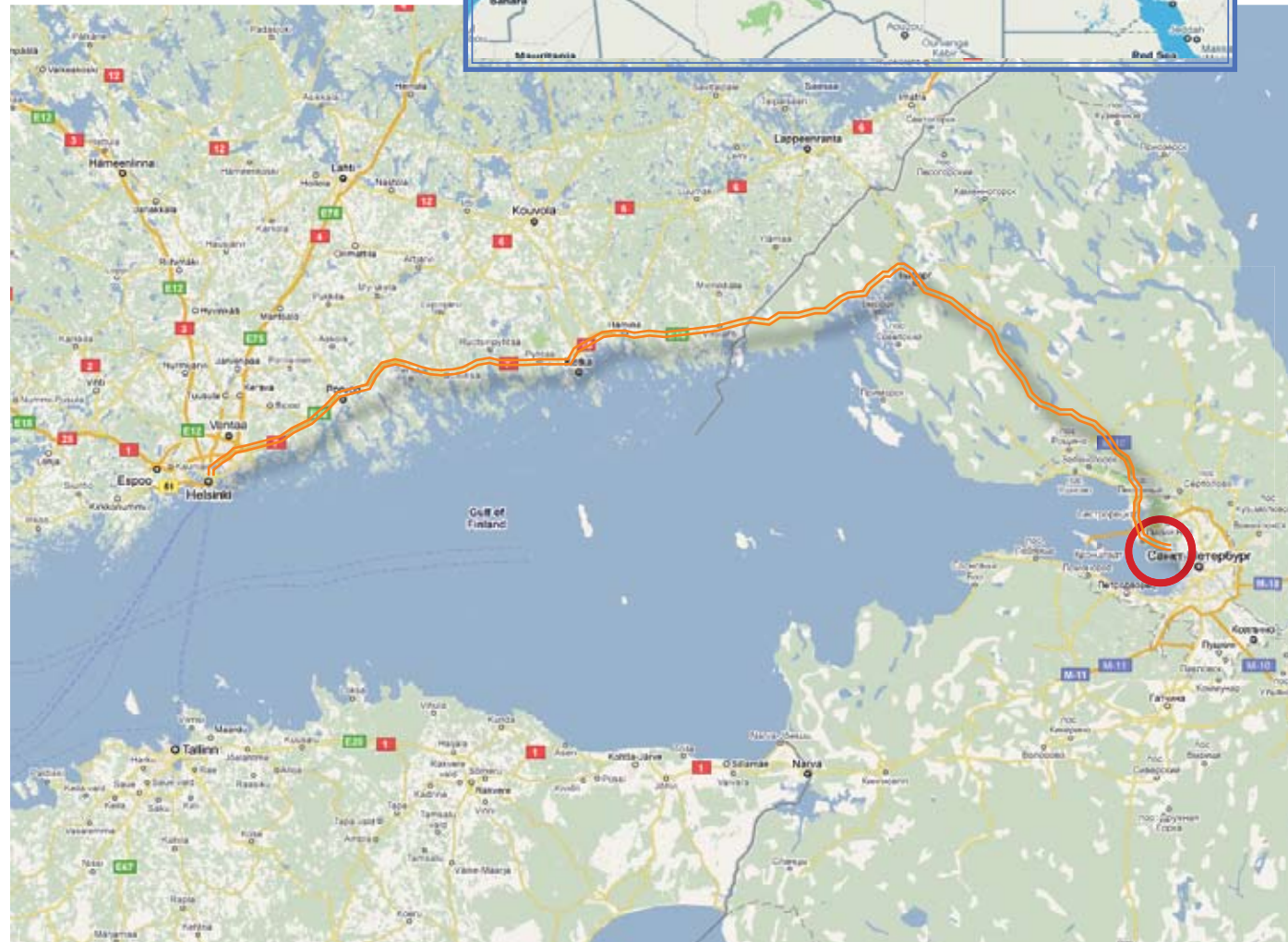
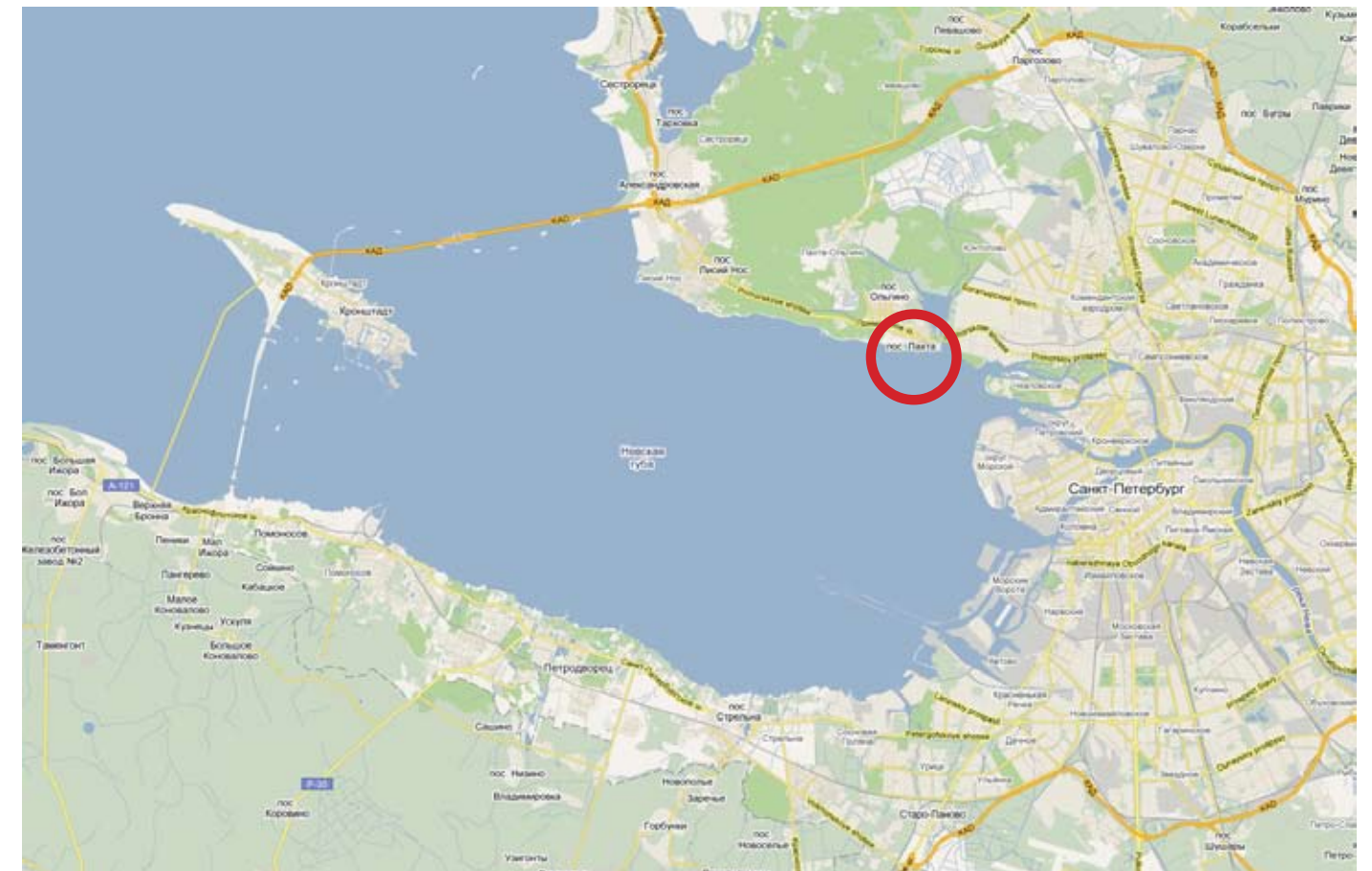
