2. Venue and Date

The Championship will be held from Wednesday 1st June to 5 June 2011 on the bay of Morges.

3. Rules

- 3.1 The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF.
- 3.2 The "Regulations for Swiss Championships" of Swiss Sailing will apply.
- 3.3 The International Dragon Class rules.
- 3.4 Sailing Instructions.
- 3.5 Notice of Race.
- 3.6 Swiss federal law for inland navigation with local amendments will apply.
- 3.7 If there is a conflict between languages the French text of this notice of race will prevail.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1 The regatta is also open to boats from other countries.
- 4.2 Competitors (skipper and crew) must be members of a Club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply.
- 4.3 A temporary Swiss Sailing licences can be purchased at registration.
- 4.4 A maximum of 45 entries will be accepted for this regatta.

5. Advertising

- 5.1 Competitor advertising is permitted.
- 5.2 Advertising is as permitted under ISAF regulation 20

6. Entry

- 6.1 Entries shall be submitted on the enclosed Entry Form, completely filled out. The following documents shall be enclosed:
- Measurement Certificate or Certificate of Conformity
 - Confirmation of club membership or Licence
 - Confirmation of the legitimacy for competitor advertising on Swiss boats
 - Confirmation of the third-party liability insurance (min. CHF 1'500'000.-- + valided in racing) .
- 6.2 The Entry shall be submitted to: Club Nautique Morgien – Place de la Navigation 1 – 1110 Morges
- 6.3 Deadline for Entries:
Entries shall be received by the Organizing Authority no later than April 15 2011 (post stamp). Late entries will be accepted April 30 2011
- 6.4 Entry fee: CHF 450.- per boat, transfered with the entry.

Entry fee for late entries: CHF 520.-
- 6.5 A package for « sailors » of CHF 90.--, for the Saturday evening Gala at the CIO Museum.
A package for « accompagnies » of CHF 150.--, for the 4 days, including the Saturday evening Gala at the CIO Museum.
Is included in the CIO evening Gala: Bus transportation, cocktails, visit of the Olympic Museum, Dinner, within the museum (wine – soft drinks, coffee and desserts included).

7.2 Scheduled Races:

- The Championship will be sailed with 9 valid races.
- To constitute the Championship at least 4 valid races must be sailed during the scheduled time.
- At one day no more than 3 valid races will be sailed.

8. Measurement

- 8.1 The check of the Measurement Certificates and the control measurements will take place in the tent next to the Clubhouse.
- 8.2 No first measurements will be carried out.

9. Courses

The race courses will be of type „Windward-Leeward course“. See attached plan

10. Penalty System

Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so as only one turn, including one tack and one jibe, is required.

11. Scoring

- 11.1 The low points scoring system of rule appendix A will apply.
- 11.2 When 4 valid races or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.3 The prize giving will be made following the protest time limit of the last race.

12. Prizes

- 12.1 The following prizes will be awarded:
- Championship Medals for the first 3 boats
 - Prizes for the first 3 boats
 - Drawing of other prize lots and daily award.

13. Mooring and Parking

- 13.1 For every boat a suitable place will be provided. Arrangements of the harbour administrator must be respected.
- 13.2 During the Championship launching and hauling will be free of charge for the Dragon competitors.
- 13.3 Special parking lots will be marked for the trailers and must be respected.
- 13.4 Parking cards for the competitors are available at the Check-in.
- 13.5 All yachts shall not be hauled out during the championship excepted with, and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Jury.

14. Liability and Insurance

- 14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 14.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event (min. 1,5 Mio CHF) and valid for racing.
